



A Practical Guide for Funeral Attendees



- ✓ Dress for the weather-you will be outside for a graveside service.
- ✓ Wear sturdy, closed shoes. High heels make it challenging to walk to the grave.
- ✓ Bring a filled water bottle in your vehicle. There is no drinking water at the cemetery.
- ✓ Upon arrival an attendant will direct you where to park.
- ✓ People with mobility challenges should hang a handicap placard on their rear view mirror or indicate to the attendant that you would like to pull up behind the hearse closer to the graveside.
- ✓ If it is sunny and hot, or rainy you might want to grab an umbrella to provide shade or weather protection.
- ✓ Walk on the mowed paths. We suggest checking for ticks when you return home.
- ✓ Anyone asked to be a pall bearer should be able to lift 25 pounds and walk on uneven ground. You will be carrying the deceased who will either be wrapped in a cloth shroud, a basket or casket.
- ✓ Mourners should silence their cell phones during the service.
- ✓ There is a portable bathroom for your use.
